TV Production III PORTFOLIO REQUIREMENTS
VERY STRICT DUE DATE- 4/24/17

Students who have completed TV II and would like to take TV III must first complete a video portfolio. The objective of this video is to present their work done in TV II. The video must be between 5 and 10 minutes. The overall packaging of the video and quality of the work will determine entrance into TV III.

The more you put into this, the better your chances are of gaining acceptance.

IMPORTANT- SIMPLY SUBMITTING A PORTFOLIO DOES NOT GUARANTEE ENTRANCE!

1. The portfolio must include the following, but can include other examples of work completed in TV I & TV II
 - a. PSA (thirty or sixty seconds)
 - b. News feature (only parts of it)
 - c. Photoshop graphics (Create a look or theme to help introduce all parts of the portfolio)
 - d. An Interview recorded outside of class (recorded correctly with a tri pod and mic)

2. Strict attention will be paid to the following:
 - a. Audio levels
 - b. Shot composition
 1. Head room
 2. Poor choice of backgrounds for interviews
 3. Shaky video
 4. Video is too dark or too bright
 - c. Music choices and how they are edited
 - d. Graphic design techniques
 - e. Overall editing, does the portfolio have any
 1. Bad edits
 2. Bad transitions
 - f. Package it- Come up with a creative way to present your work

g. Suggestions-

1. Use After Effects, documentary style, research examples on the web
2. Create a splashy open
3. Pay attention to details, for example (font and music choices)
4. Have someone else watch it and critique it
